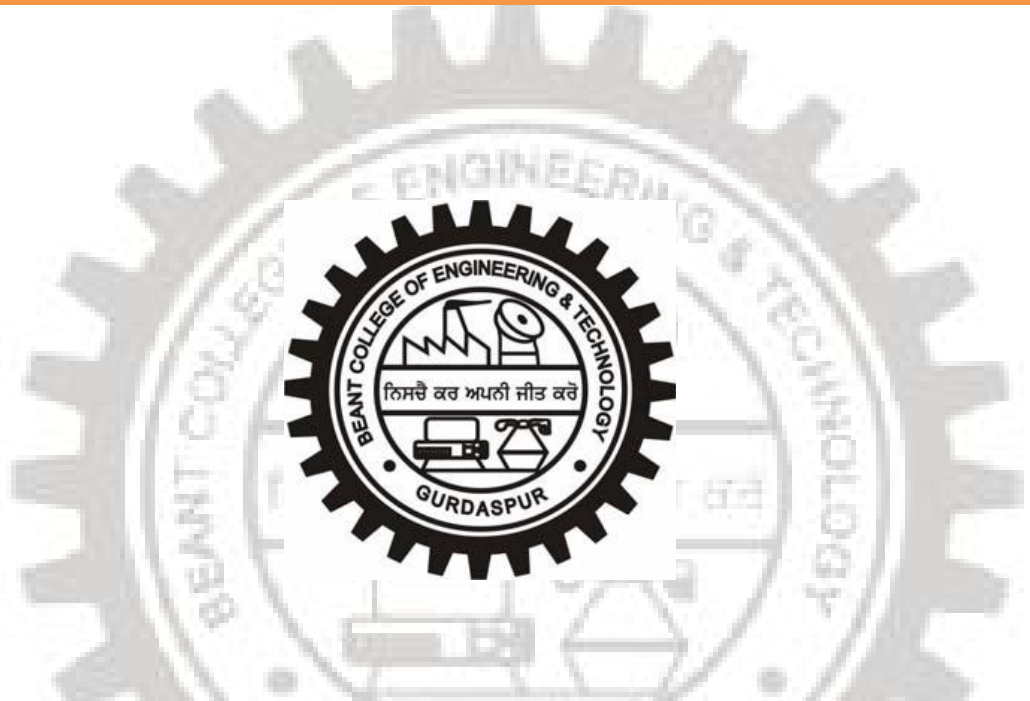

	<p><i>Moderation of result is proposed as follows:</i></p> <p>Some time due to one reasons or the other , pass percentage of students is found to be very less , Therefore it is proposed that:</p> <p>If in any regular subject(s) pass percentage in external theory examination is coming out to be less than 50% then moderation is to be carried out. Further it is clarified that this moderation will be applicable only if the minimum number of regular students appeared in the subject is 10. However, the maximum marks during moderation, given to all students should not to exceed 20% of maximum marks. The calculated moderated marks based upon regular students will also be applicable to re-appear students in the respective subjects.</p> <p>In case there is no end semester regular Exam for a subject and only reappear exam is there, then the moderation of marks will be calculated in such a way that minimum 20% students must have passed in that subject. Further the number of student appeared in the subject should be at least 10. However, the maximum marks during moderation, given to all students should not to exceed 20% of maximum marks.</p> <p>The moderation committee will be constituted by Chairman Academic Council of college as per following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Principal/Principal Nominee. • Dean Academics. • Head of concerned department. • Subject expert. • Controller of Examination. <p>Item is presented & may please be approved.</p>

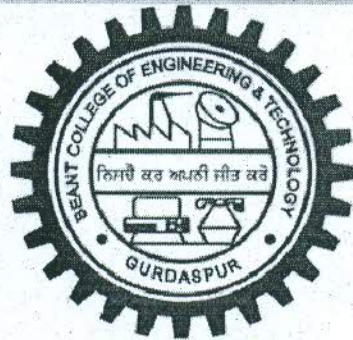

Item was discussed and following changes were suggested:

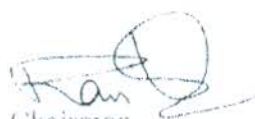
- a) In the subject BTMP-101 Manufacturing Practice, industrial visits for students should be included.

- c) It was suggested to assign contact hrs unit wise in all the syllabus.


Item No. 2.7 **Any other item with the permission of Chair.**
