Item No. 1.5 Pattern of the question paper

It is proposed to change the pattern of question paper for the end term theory examination for UG and PG courses and is presented below:

Question paper will have three sections viz. Section A, Section B and Section C. Section A will be compulsory and will have one third weightage of the total marks. This section will have 20 objective type questions covering entire syllabus of one marks each. Section B will consists of five questions from the entire syllabus out of which any four questions (five marks each) have to be attempted. These questions will be of subjective, short answer type and should

be designed to test theoretical/analytical/numerical skills of the students. The last section C will consists of three questions covering entire syllabus and any two questions(ten marks each) need to be attempted. The questions will be of subjective long answer type covering detailed derivations/analytical/detailed design numerical problems etc.

Item No. 1.6 Remuneration for the Paper-setters, conduct of examination etc.

PTU norms will be followed for all kinds of remuneration regarding paper setting and conduct of end semester theory and practical examinations.
