Institution's responsibilities towards students

Principal

- Offers programmes that are consistent with Institute's vision, mission and objectives with adequate academic flexibility.

- Provides uncompromising quality education with all its facets – Teaching, Learning, Research and Extension.

Dean (Academic Affairs)

- Offers programmes that are consistent with Institute's vision, mission and objectives with adequate academic flexibility.
- Provides the students with clear and accessible information relating to their studies, such as details of what to expect in their programmes and modules and a clear and accessible academic timetable.
- Provides clear information to students about admission and completion requirements for all programmes, the fee structure and refund policies, financial aid and student support services.

Heads of Department

- Communicate department/programme's vision, mission and objectives systematically and clearly to all the students in line with the Institute's vision and mission.
- Obtain feedback from students on the review and redesign of course curriculum.

Controller of Examination

Chief Warden and Wardens

- Promote self discipline amongst students and provide safe and healthy environment to enable the students to celebrate life in its full glory.

Librarian

- Ensures access to a wide range of learning resources and facilities appropriate to students' academic programme and professional development.

Student advisors

- Implement a well-conceived plan for monitoring student progress continuously and provide mentoring and counseling to students with the help of counselors.

Student's responsibilities of learning
